



The Orchards at Greentree Homeowners Association

POOL RULES

1. A valid 2016 Orchards at Greentree pool pass will be required for entry. No other pool pass or form of ID will be accepted. **POOL PASSES ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE. You must live in the Orchards at Greentree.**
2. You must be current on association dues, fees and fines to be eligible for pool passes. Pool passes can be revoked at any time if you become delinquent. Satisfaction of outstanding debts or fines will result in restoration of all privileges.
3. All guests must be accompanied by a resident. Any resident bringing a guest(s) takes full responsibility for that guest, including, but not limited to, the adherence to the pool rules and regulations
4. Lifeguard has the right to eject:
 - a. Any person who appears to be a threat to him/herself or others.
 - b. Any person who requires exceptional attention from the lifeguard preventing him/her from carrying out his/her responsibilities.
5. Floats, balls, water guns, toys or inflatables are not permitted in the pool. Exceptions: Styrofoam noodles and children's safety equipment.
6. Inclement weather pool closing is at the discretion of the lifeguard in consultation with a Recreation Management supervisor and where possible with the approval of at least one Board of Trustees.
7. No jumping or diving from the shallow end of the pool is permitted.
8. No pets are permitted in the pool area.
9. No running or pushing permitted in the pool area.
10. Showers should be taken prior to entering the pool.
11. Bathing suits are required at all times. Persons wearing other types of clothing will not be permitted in the pool.
12. Children not toilet trained are NOT permitted in the pool. Paper diapers are not permitted in either the baby pool or main pool. Cloth diapers or training pants covered with plastic pants are permitted in the baby pool only.
13. Anyone in the pool area under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
14. No glass of any kind is permitted in the pool/patio area.
15. All trash must be disposed of in the containers provided.
16. There will be NO SMOKING permitted in the pool area. There will be a designated area for smoking outside the main pool gate entrance. Cigarette butts must be disposed of properly.
17. Food is permitted only near the chairs and table; not in the pool.
18. Alcoholic beverages cannot be brought to or consumed in the pool area
19. Lounges and chairs are not permitted on the cement walkways.

20. Lounges and chairs cannot be 'reserved'; tables shall not be relocated from their original location.
21. Bicycles and skateboards are not permitted within the pool grounds.
22. No person will be permitted to enter the pool if his/her health does not warrant such entry. This rule applies to colds, skin irritations, etc., or any communicable ailment or disease.
23. Anyone under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication affecting their alertness will be prohibited from entering or asked to leave the pool.
24. Disregard of pool regulations may result in revoking pool privileges.
25. In addition to the pool rules listed above, all residents and their guests are required to comply with the NJ State Sanitary Code on Public Recreational Bathing, N.J.A.C. 8:26-5.4, provided below verbatim:
 - a) Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
 - b) Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts or bandages shall be denied admission.
 - c) Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms or gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
 - d) All children in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fit elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in bathing water.
 - e) Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any 'accidents' you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
 - f) No animals, except for service animals shall be allowed in the swimming pool, wading pool, hot tub, or spa area, dressing rooms, or other parts of the enclosure.
 - g) Glass containers shall be prohibited in food and drink areas.
 - h) All persons shall shower before entering the water.
 - i) Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
 - j) Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
 - k) Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.
