SAFETY REMINDERS – DRYER VENTS

Each year over 15,000 home fires are caused by dryers - these types of fires can occur when lint builds up in your dryer and exhaust duct. To ensure your safety, here are a few tips:

1. Be sure to clean your lint screen / filter before or after drying each load of laundry.
2. Clean the vent and exhaust periodically. Check the outside dryer vent while the dryer is in use to be sure exhaust air is escaping.

Not only does cleaning your dryer vent provide added safety, it can save you between \$15–\$25 each month in energy savings!
