Parking Issues

The Board acknowledges that while assigned parking has relieved some neighborhood concerns, it also brought about new ones

for residents and visitors who are parking curbside. DO NOT BLOCK mailboxes and fire hydrants. The Board is resuming plans to paint yellow curbs this spring in order to clearly designate unsafe parking areas, without taking away too many parking opportunities. In addition, when hosting a party at your townhome, instruct your visitors to be considerate and respectful of your neighbors and our community's parking guidelines. You may utilize the clubhouse parking lot if needed.



Trash & Waste Disposal

Another trash reminder is necessary due to residents carelessly throwing unsecured trash to the curb. Please help us keep our neighborhood clean! Per Evesham Township ordinance, all trash must be in a tightly sealed, commercially produced container (including dog waste bags). For Thursday trash days, containers are to be placed out at 6:00pm Wednesdays and must be removed by 6:00pm Thursdays.
