#### **Neighborhood Beautification**

One of the planned projects the Board announced in late 2019 was to invest in updating our Orchards community entrance

signs. As we are getting quotes and finalizing the design, we hope to have this project completed by late Summer or early Fall. This means three new signs to replace the faded ones at Roberts, Elberta, and Harvest, and one new sign with landscaping at the Red Haven entrance. We are also in process of working with our landscaper to plan out tree-trimming and maintenance of common grounds through each of our four courts.

### Trash & Recycling

Each newsletter we remind residents to be mindful of their trash disposal habits and this issue is no exception. **Trash** <u>must</u> be

secured in sealed, commercially produced containers and placed curbside no earlier than 6:00pm Wednesdays and removed no later than 6:00pm Thursdays. Items too large for the trash bin or certain materials (metal, debris, etc.) can be taken to Evesham Township Department of Public Works, which have resumed their normal Monday—Saturday 7am-2pm hours, no appointments needed. Please be conscious of the correct Recycling Friday dates. You can download the RecycleCoach app for weekly reminders. Need an extra blue bucket? You can pick one up using your ID at the Public Works office during operating hours.



### Speeding & Parking

Speeding continues to be a significant issue throughout our community. Please be courteous and obey the posted speed limits.

Especially during these summertime months, children are out and about and riding their bikes. Our children's safety is of the utmost importance and reckless driving is unacceptable. In addition, while COVID-19 has delayed the Board's yellow curb project, we are resuming plans to enforce parking safety standards throughout our neighborhood. Below are a few parking reminders for residents <u>and</u> guests:

- Do <u>not</u> block fire hydrants or mailboxes.
- Visitor spots are for visitors only, not residents.
- Be courteous of parking on both sides of a street or in blind spots.
- Overflow parking is permitted at the Clubhouse parking lot.

A NOTE FROM THE BOARD

Since mid-March, COVID-19 has caused life interruptions and inconveniences for many of us. Unfortunately, this extends to our community amenities. Originally, our tot lots, basketball court, and tennis courts were closed in accordance with orders set by the Governor and local municipalities. We optimistically prepared to open the pool (with fresh new pumps and pipes) and distributed pool passes in hopes of a quick opening once the Governor's announcement was made.

After consulting with our HOA attorney and insurance company for weeks on end, the Board voted on July 9, 2020 to close the Orchards pool for the remainder of the season and to keep the other amenities (tot lots, basketball court, tennis courts) closed for the time being. Know that this was **not** a decision the Board took lightly, but the lack of insurance coverage and heightened risk for the Board members and **all** individual homeowners were just too great to ignore.

A summary of the July 9<sup>th</sup> meeting and further details from our attorney were emailed and mailed to all residents. The Board's purpose is to keep our residents safe and to protect the financial interest of our community. We are just as disappointed as you to not have access to these amenities, but it is out of an abundance of caution and with our community's best interests in mind. Here's to hoping for a better and brighter 2021. We hope you are all staying safe and healthy.
